What to expect...

Once a date has been set, a member of the Victorian Branch Water Ski Unit will visit your group (on a night that suits), to talk you through what to expect of the trip. We'll run through the gear to bring (and what we'll supply) and familiarize your group with some of the procedures and rules of the team that all participants need to be aware of before coming away.

On the booked date when everyone arrives at the lake or river and is ready to go, a talk is given to rehash the details covered in the information session and to introduce the team that will be teaching on the trip (boat drivers, observers, teachers etc); from there, we proceed to the waters edge and let the fun begin.

An average weekend away with the team includes 3, 4 hour sessions by the water; guaranteed to have your group physically exhausted and sleeping contently all the way home.

Got what it takes to be a member?

The Victorian Branch Water Ski Unit is made up of over 40 members, has approximately 10-15 ski trips away every season and is the perfect fun way to spend a weekend.

The team is always looking for those that are interested in teaching youth and improving their own skills at the same time. If you enjoy being skied by the team;
